Directions

- **Adults and children 12 years of age and older:** 1 to 2 tablets every 4 hours, not to exceed 12 tablets in 24 hours
- **Children 6-11 years of age:** ½ to 1 tablet every 4 hours, not to exceed 6 tablets in 24 hours
- **Children under 6 years of age:** consult a doctor
